Bus Times will be as follows:

Tuesday 10th to Friday 13th December – bus run as normal – We will leave by 9am sharp each day

For Tuesday and Friday swimming students may come to school dressed in their swimmers (rash shirt and hat) and either sandals or thongs but must have a packed uniform (2 towels/shirt/shorts/trousers/jumper/underwear/socks & shoes) to change into, a towel to use during lessons as well as a towel to dry themselves with at the end of each day. The school will provide sunscreen throughout the day. Students will need to pack a big recess, lunch and plenty of water as swimming can make students extra hungry and thirsty. Students will only be able to buy from the shop on the last day of swimming, Friday 13th December.

Final Transition into Kindergarten – Monday 16th December

Our last transition day for preschool students coming into Kindergarten next year, 2014, will be next Monday 16th December from 9am to 12noon. We will be holding our End of Year Presentation on Monday 16th December at 5.30pm. Students are to go home after school and then return with parents/carers at 5pm in full school uniform (sport shirt) ready for the presentation to begin at 5.30pm. Our students will be performing a number of theatrical items and receiving awards for their ongoing efforts and achievements. We are asking

End of Year Excursion to Coffs Harbour – Tuesday 17th December

We will be travelling to Coffs Harbour on Tuesday 17th December for our end of year excursion. We will be travelling to and from Coffs Harbour on Jim's bus and will need to leave Tyringham Store at 8am. We will be 9 Pin Bowling first, then recess at the Jetty Beach (not swimming), where students can participate in sandcastle building followed by lunch and play at Brelsford Park prior to catching bus home. The P&C have kindly offered to pay for Jim's bus for the day.

The only cost to students will be \$12 each for Nine Pin Bowling. Students can catch the High School Bus run in the morning. Those students who do not catch the bus will need to be at Tyringham Store by 8am. Students will catch the High School Bus run home in the afternoon. Those students who not catch the bus will need to be collected at Tyringham Shop at 4pm. Students will need to wear full school uniform (sport shirts if possible) and a hat on the day. They will need to bring a packed recess, lunch, afternoon snack and plenty of water to drink throughout the day. Please sign and return the attached consent note and money if attached.
