<u>Yr 6 Orientation – Dorrigo High School – This Wednesday 4th December – All Day</u>

Bus Times will be as follows:

Thursday 5th December – leave school at 12noon and return to school by 3.30pm – bus run as normal Tuesday 10th to Friday 13th December – bus run as normal – We will leave by 9am sharp each day

On Thursday students are to come to school in uniform and get changed at school prior to heading into the pool.

For Tuesday and Friday swimming students may come to school dressed in their swimmers (rash shirt and hat) and either sandals or thongs but must have a packed uniform (**2 towels**/shirt/shorts/trousers/jumper/underwear/socks & shoes) to change into, a towel to use during sessions as well as a towel to dry themselves with at the end of each day. The school will provide sunscreen throughout the day. Students will need to pack a big recess, lunch and plenty of water as swimming can make students extra hungry and thirsty. Students will only be able to buy from the shop on the last day of swimming, Friday 13th December.

Non- Uniform Day – Monday 16th December

Students may come to school on Monday 16th December in non-uniform for the day, this way uniforms will be nice and clean for presentation night.

End of Year Presentation – Monday 16th December – 5pm

We will be holding our End of Year Presentation on Monday 16th December at 5.30pm. Students are to go home after school and then return with parents/carers at 5pm in full school uniform (sport shirt) ready for the presentation to begin at 5.30pm. Our students





will be performing a number of theatrical items and receiving awards for their ongoing efforts and achievements. Good News from Dorrigo Youth Clinic

Dorrigo Youth Clinic Committee(DYCC) -have received a grant from Transport For NSW of \$8000 to fund transport for Dorrigo Plateau youth to attend social events. Called 'Plateau Out', the grant will be used for transport to social (e.g. music, sporting) events held outside Dorrigo Plateau area but also to bring youth to events held on the Plateau-(e.g. to events in Dundurrabin). The aim of the program is to reduce social isolation for our youth by providing access to a range of social activities they may otherwise not be able to attend. DYCC would like to hear from parents and interested community members who are willing to be involved –either as helpers on trips or planning pickups, designing information posters. A combination of transport types will be used depending on numbers -Small buses with volunteer drivers, commercial bus services etc. We would also like to hear from any volunteer bus drivers out there who are
